Bishop Will Willimon is a courageous writer. In his 2022 book *Don't Look Back*, he took the United Methodist Church to task, saying that we neither make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world nor have open minds, open hearts, and open doors. He asserted then that the median age in the UMC is 63 and added that any organization whose median age is 63 is automatically in decline. He surmised that the church should not look back – specifically not look back at where we were before COVID – and instead look to Jesus Christ for the future and ministry of the church.

Bishop Willimon's focus on the future and ministry of the church is addressed in his latest book, *The Last Supper: Conversations That Led to the Cross* [above]. Willimon delves into Jesus' parables in this Lenten study, which starts at Oaklette Tuesday, Feb. 24.
